Privacy Statement

What personal data do we collect?

Your personal data (any information which identifies you, or which can be identified as relating to you personally for example, name, address, phone number, email address) will be collected and used by us. We will only collect the personal data that we need.

We collect personal data in connection with specific activities such as registration or membership requests, donations, volunteering, etc. You can give us your personal data by filling in forms or by corresponding with us (by phone, email or by joining as a member).

Your activities and involvement with us may result in personal data being created. This could include details of how you've helped us by volunteering or being involved with our services and activities.

How do we treat the data that we collect?

We process personal data lawfully, fairly and in a transparent way.

We collect personal data only for specified, explicit and legitimate purposes.

We process personal data only where it is adequate, relevant and limited to what is necessary for the purposes of processing.

We keep accurate personal data and take all reasonable steps to ensure that inaccurate personal data is rectified or deleted without delay.

We keep personal data in a form which permits identification from personal data for no longer than is necessary for the purpose of the processing or, if for longer periods, for such reasons as permitted by the GDPR.

We adopt appropriate measures to make sure that personal data is secure, and protected against unauthorised or unlawful processing, and accidental loss, destruction or damage.

How we use your information?
